In Memorium

Larry Penn was a Milwaukee singer, songwriter, activist, poet, toymaker, truck driver, husband, father and friend. He was the Cookie Man and appeared on these stages 13 times since 1981. Larry died in October at 87.

Chris Aaron was a musician's musician, a blues man. Chris first came to the Festival as a child with his mother, Anna Lee Scully. He occasionally played on stage with her, but 2014 marked what should have been the first appearance of the Chris Aaron Blues Band. Chris died at 44 in October 2014.

Johnny Doxtator sang at the Festival almost every year since 2004. He was a folksinger from Gresham and loved singing gospel and country. He died in spring. He was 75.

Guy Carawan appeared at the Festival in 1985 and he left his mark. Guy was a folksinger, folklorist, activist, and the music director for the Highlander School in Tennessee. In 1960 he introduced "We Shall Overcome," turning it into the universal protest song. Guy died in May 2015 at 87.

We've also lost other festival friends and family. This weekend, sing for all of them.

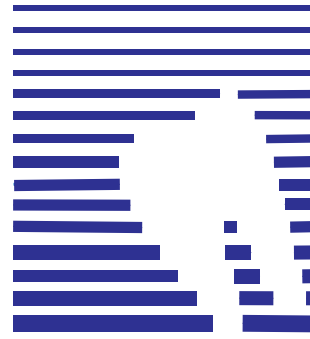

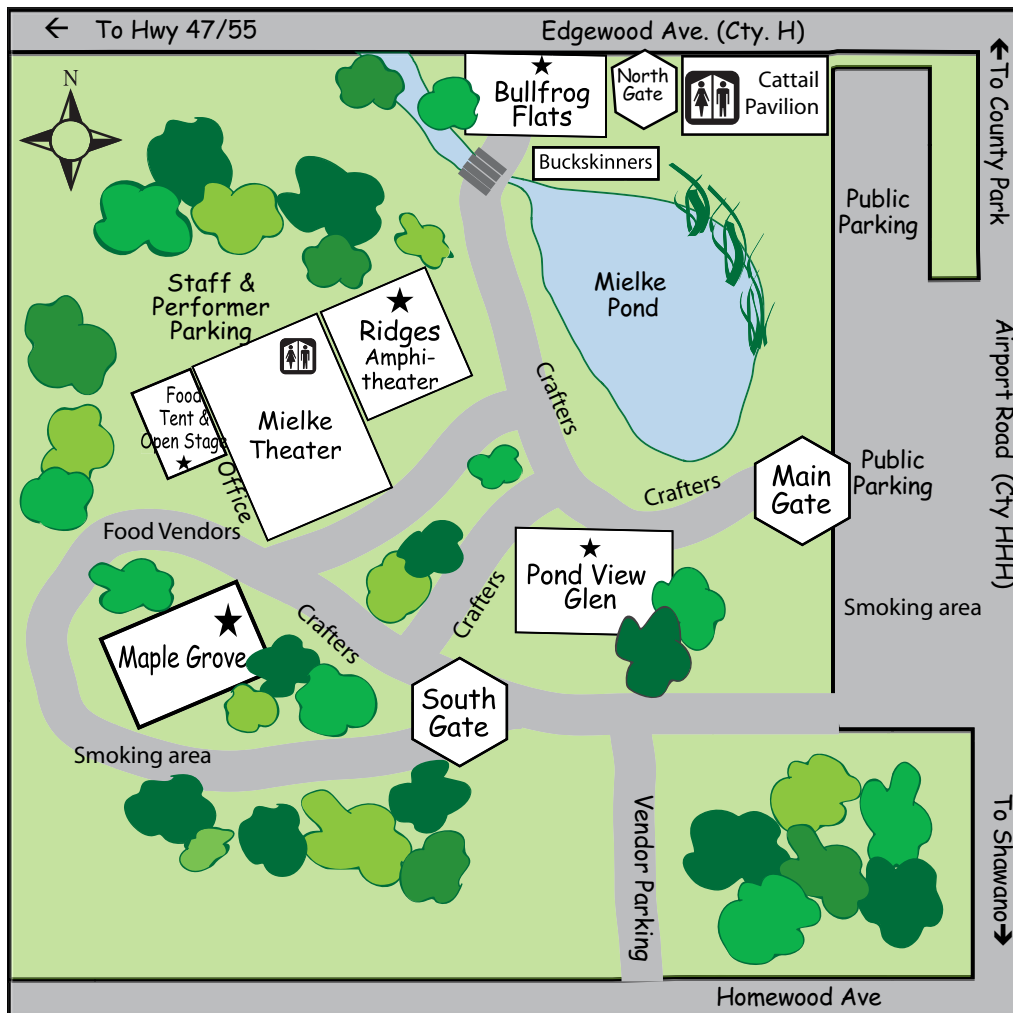
